

## **Summer Speech Camp – Summer 2010**

Middleburg Early Education Center's Summer Speech Camp is a 7-week program designed to help children with special needs maintain the skills they have gained during the school year. Children attend two or three days each week for sessions that last two hours. One thirty-minute speech-language therapy session each week is included in the fee.

### **Purpose:**

1. To develop communication skills. This process is incorporated in overall programming during classroom activities. Private speech therapy is also provided one time each week
2. To provide social experiences which are designed to encourage play skills and the use of verbal skills.
3. To maintain pre-academic skills and promote cognitive development.
4. To develop positive self-esteem and a positive attitude towards others.

2<sup>nd</sup> Session 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

### **Cost:**

Two Days each week (Tuesdays and Thursdays) \$410.00

Three Days each week (Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays) \$600.00
